

# TPM Ommen (NL), 6. – 8. March 2023

## Day 1 – Monday, March 6

The third Transnational Project Meeting (TPM3) of the SAVLAR project commenced in Ommen, with participants arriving in the morning.

In the morning, all partners gathered in the hotel lobby before heading to a warming-up activity in the green surroundings of Ommen. This informal session provided a great opportunity for team bonding and setting the tone for the meeting.

The group then had lunch at Erve Vechtdal farm before diving into the first working session. The focus of this session was the online course, where participants worked in groups of three to conduct a detailed analysis of the course chapters. The key questions discussed were:
